

Central Ohio District NMI Scholarship

An annual \$1000.00 scholarship is to be presented to a high school senior, a college freshman, or a college sophomore from a Nazarene church on the Central Ohio District who is enrolled in a Nazarene college or university and is actively pursuing a call to missions. The scholarship funds will be credited to the recipient's college account at the beginning of his/her junior year (or at the beginning of the senior year if the scholarship is awarded during the sophomore year) provided the recipient is still actively pursuing a call to missions.

Who should apply?

Any high school senior or college freshman or sophomore student from a Central Ohio District Church of the Nazarene who is attending a Nazarene college or university and is actively pursuing a call to missions.

What is the amount of the award?

The selected student will receive \$1000.00 credited to their school account at the beginning of the junior year (or at the beginning of the senior year if the scholarship is awarded during the sophomore year), provided he/she is still actively pursuing a call to missions.

Is there a renewal each year?

This is a one-time scholarship.

- two letters of reference (written by pastors, youth pastors, teachers, employers, or mentors. Recommendations from family members will not be accepted. Letters from a previous year are acceptable.)
